



CONCEPT

This project integrates urban farming into a residential environment, reimagining underutilised spaces to enhance productivity, community engagement, and cultural connection. Drawing from West End's rich heritage, the concept brings the tradition of winemaking into an urban context, creating spaces where people can connect, learn, and participate in the process. Garden structures, compost stations, and horticultural elements form the architecture to foster sustainability, self-sufficiency, and social interaction, resulting in a responsive and adaptable residential design.
